

MIGRATION VISAS

Who should Apply

Migrant visas provide permanent entry and stay in Australia. The following migrant visas are processed by the Australian High Commission, Colombo:

- Partners (fiancé and spouse);
- Children (natural, adopted and orphan relative);
- Aged dependent relatives;
- Remaining relatives; or
- Carers (who care for)

Which are sponsored by Australian citizens, Australian permanent resident visa holders and eligible New Zealand citizens

Accompanying family members (spouse and dependent children) may be included in an application at no extra charge.

What you must provide

Partners and children (natural, adopted)

- Rs 192,500.00 Non-refundable fee in the form of a bank draft payable to the “Australian High Commission – Colombo”;

Children (orphan relative), aged dependent relatives, remaining relatives and carers

- Rs 117,600.00 Non-refundable fee in the form of a bank draft payable to the “Australian High Commission – Colombo”;

Partner

- 47SP Application for migration to Australia as a partner (all questions must be completed and form must be signed); and
- 40 SP Sponsorship for a partner to migrate to Australia (all questions must be completed and form must be signed); or

Child

- 47CH Application for migration to Australia as a child (all questions must be completed and form must be signed); and
- 40CH Sponsorship for a child to migrate to Australia (all questions must be completed and form must be signed); or

Other Family

- 47OF Application for migration to Australia by other family relatives (aged dependent relative, remaining relative or carer) (all questions must be completed and form must be signed); and
- 40 Sponsorship for migration to Australia (all questions must be completed and form must be signed)

Carer (additional mandatory requirement)

- If applying for a Carer Migrant visa, evidence that you have obtained an assessment by Health Services Australia

What you should provide

- Four recent passport size photos of each applicant and two recent passport sized photos of the sponsor.

What you may provide

Each migrant visa has a Migration Booklet with a complete list of all information and documents that should be lodged with your application:

Partner Migration	Booklet 1
Child Migration	Booklet 2
Other Family Migration	Booklet 4

It is very important that you read the booklets and provide all of the documents and forms needed to make a decision on your application. The attached checklist to this leaflet may be of further assistance to you.

Health and character requirements

All applicants are required to meet health requirements.

- Applicants seeking a migrant visa and are over the age of 11 are required to undergo a chest x-ray.
- Applicants seeking a migrant visa are required to undergo a medical examination

If required applicants will be provided with medical examination form 26 and/or chest x-ray form 160 and a list of approved panel doctors at the time they lodge their application. Applicants must provide two additional passport size photographs for this purpose.

All applicants aged 17 years and over are required to meet character requirements. In most cases, an applicant will be required to obtain a police check from those countries in which they resided for 12 months or more in the last 10 years. The Form 47P provides instructions on how to obtain police checks.

Other information

Please do not supply original documents with your applications unless we ask for them. All photocopies must be certified.

Documents in languages other than English must be accompanied by certified English translation.

If you do not provide all the requested documents, a decision may be made on the information you have provided. It is in your interest to support your application with as much information as possible at the time you apply.

If applying as a partner - evidence of relationship (refer Partner Migration Booklet)
If applying as a child - evidence of relationship (refer Child Migration Booklet)
If applying as an aged dependent relative - evidence of relationship and dependency (refer Other Family Migration Booklet)
If applying as a remaining relative - evidence you are a remaining relative (refer Other Family Migration Booklet)
If applying as a carer - evidence of carer relationship and health services certificate (refer Other Family Migration Booklet)

Where you are required to provide a photocopy you will need to have the copy certified as being a true copy of the original document.

Each certificate you must provide original language version and an English translation.
